

- 1 1. The Owner of an unaltered female dog shall not allow the whelping of more
2 than one litter within the permit year.
- 3 2. No offspring may be sold, adopted, bartered or otherwise transferred,
4 whether for compensation or otherwise, until such offspring has reached the
5 age of at least eight (8) weeks.
- 6 3. The Owner must prominently display their Unaltered Dog License number in
7 any advertisement to the public for the sale, adoption or transfer (whether for
8 compensation or otherwise) of the offspring. The Owner must provide the
9 Unaltered Dog License number to any person who purchases, adopts or
10 receives the offspring and include the Unaltered Dog License number on any
11 receipt of sale or transfer document.
- 12 4. The Owner shall submit in writing to the License Collector the name, address
13 and telephone number of the person(s) who received any of the offspring,
14 whether for compensation or otherwise, within five (5) days of the sale or
15 transfer.
- 16 5. The Owner shall provide to all persons who receive any offspring, whether
17 for compensation or otherwise, an application for a Fresno County dog
18 license, as well as written information regarding Fresno County's dog license
19 requirements. The Owner shall obtain these documents from the License
20 Collector.

21 **9.04.047 Sale And Other Transfer Of Dogs And Cats.**

- 22 A. No person shall give away any dog or cat as a prize or as an inducement to enter
23 into any contest, lottery, drawing, game or competition.
 - 24 B. No person shall give away any dog or cat as an inducement to enter a place of
25 business, or to enter into a business arrangement.
 - 26 C. No person shall sell or give away any dog or cat in any public place or in front of
27 any business not owned by him/her or at any swap meet.

1 D. No person shall sell, barter, exchange or offer for adoption, whether for
2 compensation or otherwise, any dog or cat to any minor under the age of eighteen
3 years, without the written permission of one of the minor's parents or legal
4 guardians.

5 **9.04.049 Enforcement of Dog License Provisions.**

6 A. Any violation of sections 9.04.030, 9.04.040, 9.04.045 or 9.04.047 shall be an
7 infraction and may be enforced pursuant to Chapter 1.13, Administrative Fines, of
8 this Ordinance Code. For purposes of enforcing the provisions of sections
9 9.04.030, 9.04.040, 9.04.045 or 9.04.047, "Enforcement Officer", as defined in
10 section 1.13.040 of this Ordinance Code, shall include any agency, its agents and
11 employees, that provides animal control and/or dog licensing under contract with
12 the County of Fresno."

13 **Section 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect
14 March 1, 2006.
